

The Scottish Cancer Prevention Network Art & Design Prize for Creative Communication

Each year, the SCPN invites applications to our Art & Design competition, from students at Scotland's art & design schools. New for this year, eligible projects can be developed at any stage during degree-level study, and as before, entries may be in any medium, but should involve behaviours which are identified as impacting on our risk of developing cancer: bodyweight, physical activity/inactivity, smoking, alcohol consumption, UV radiation and nutrition etc.

The winner receives a cash award, but perhaps more importantly, has their design publicised on social media and in our newsletter, which is circulated to several thousand individuals throughout Scotland and beyond, with the hope that good ideas can be taken further and used to help raise awareness of cancer prevention, or perhaps in other intended ways. Winners are provided with a certificate and an SCPN prize seal, which can be used on your portfolio site and/or print materials to show visitors that your work is award winning. Our 2015 prizewinner was featured on STV and in several Scottish newspapers.
